

## TECHNICAL NOTE

## EVERWOOD FOR USE ON TIMBER FLOORS, STRUCTURES AND FURNITURE

The application of Everwood will improve the durability of the timber against fungus, mould and insect damage.

The Everwood can be sprayed or brushed onto the timber surface where it will enhance the durability of the timber. The application of the Everwood will also harden the timber surface, thereby increasing its strength and also giving increased abrasion resistance.

It is particularly suitable for the application to floors, walls, beams and cladding where its waterproof qualities may also help to prevent the ingress of water, oils and aggressive chemicals into the surface.

## APPLICATION

- 1. The surface must be clean and free from dust, oils and grease before the Everwood is applied. If the surface is dirty, first wipe the surface clean with a dry cloth.
- 2. The Everwood can best applied by brush, following the natural grain of the wood.
- 3. Work across the entire surface ensuring complete coverage. If patches of the timber are very permeable and the material soaks in rapidly, re-brush the affected areas.
- 4. If the surface needs to be painted, allow at least 7 days for the Everwood to fully cure.
- 5. The Everwood may darken or lighten the timber. Test a small area first, before commencing the impregnation process on a large area.
